

Notes from the Board meeting of 19th November 2018

1. A laptop will be purchased for the Men's Captain with dedicated software installed so that it can be passed on year by year. The Ladies' section committee has decided to retain a manual system.
2. A new list of keyholders has been produced and will be published in the 2019 Fixture Book. A copy will also be displayed in the pavilion.
3. The remaining protective mats will be converted before the beginning of next season.
4. As requested at the last AGM, the annual membership fee will be standardised for all members.
5. Weather permitting, the green will be open for prospective new members and coaches on Saturday 13th April, and for all members from Monday 15th April.
6. Competition Rules – the rules for the Kirby Cup and Steve Jones Plate will be amended as follows: this competition is played by first game losers of the Championship as a separate event. Similarly, for the Coronation and Jubilee Cups: the first game losers of the above usually play for a plate under the same rules.
7. Low entries for competitions – in future Men's competitions will only be run if there are sufficient entries for a full set of quarter-finals.
8. Personal items should not be left in the pavilion. If you have any items such as bowls bags, clothing etc in the changing rooms they should be removed before the end of the year. Also out-of-date notices will be taken down and there will be a reorganisation of the boards near the front door. Please note also that if you wish to display a notice that is not directly related to BNBC business you should ask the permission of the Chairman or the Club Secretary.
